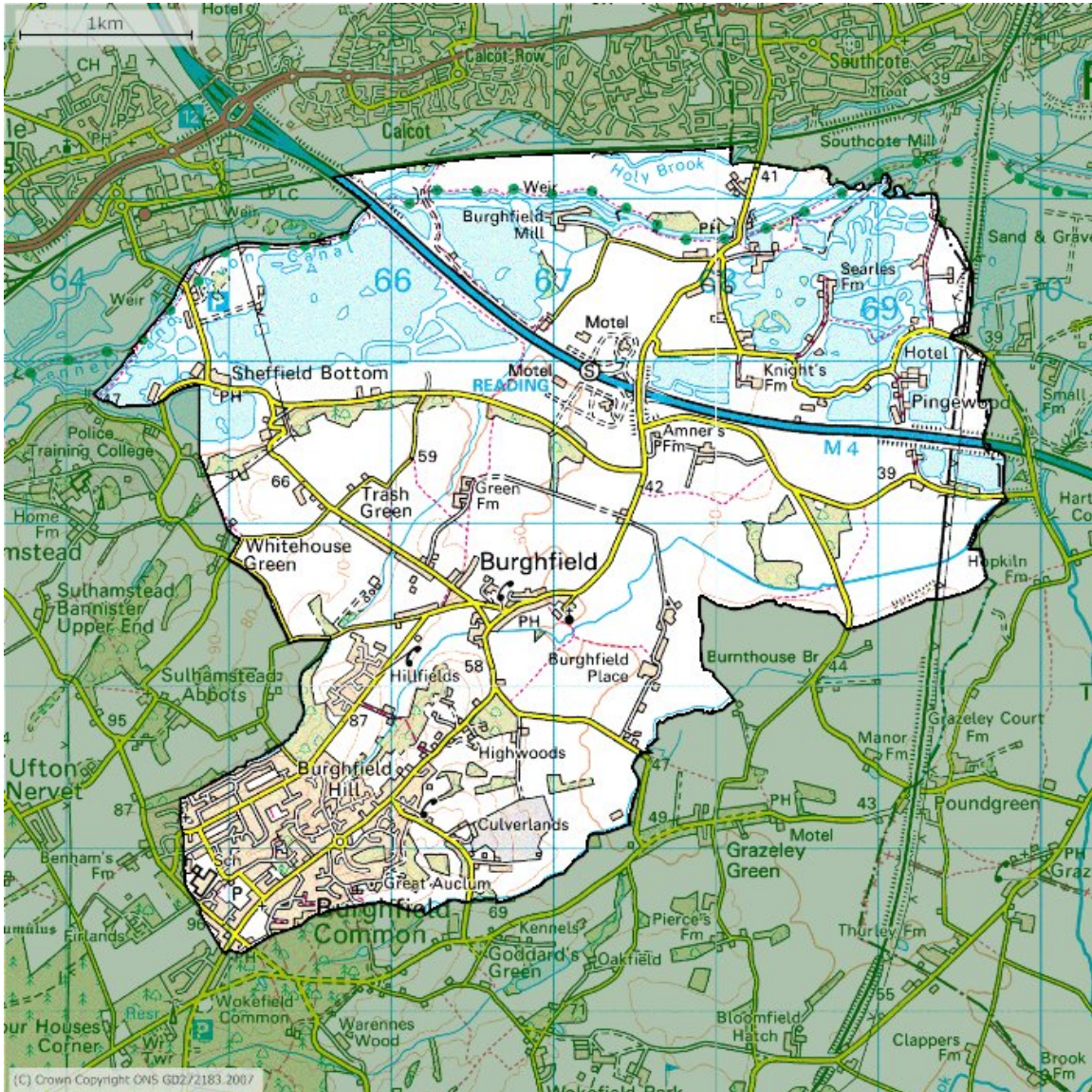

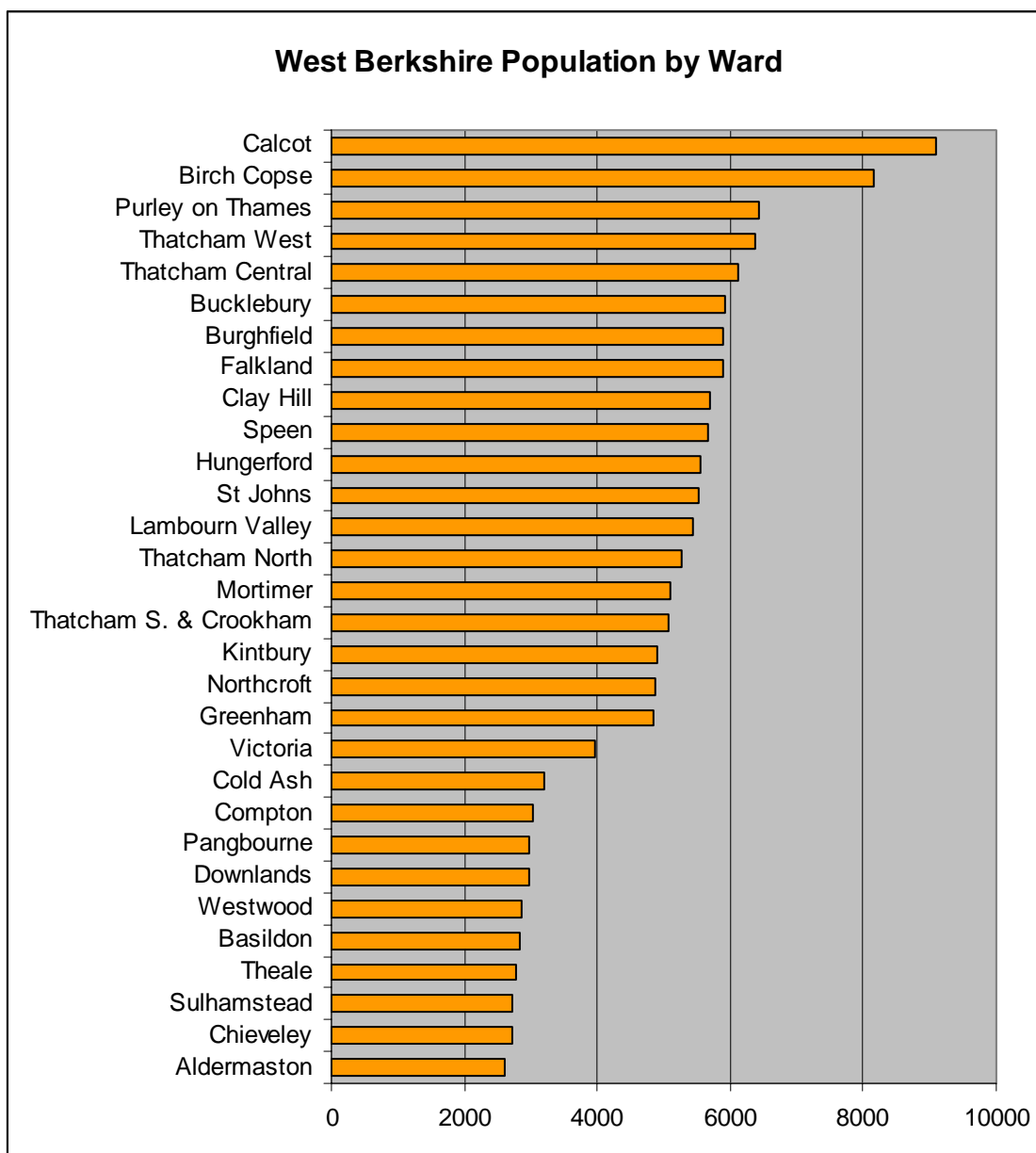

WARD PROFILE – Burghfield

1. INDEX OF MULTIPLE DEPRIVATION

The Index of Multiple Deprivation (IMD) is measured at the Super Output Area (SOA) level rather than at the Ward level. SOAs are becoming increasingly common in reporting small area statistics.

These are smaller than wards - with standardised populations of approximately 1,500 people in each. The number of SOAs therefore varies between wards. In total, there are 32,482 SOAs in England.

The IMD are a means used by both central and local government to gain a better understanding of the scale and type of deprivation experienced by people. The indices measure a number of factors (income, employment, health, education, barriers to services, the environment and crime) to capture the spread of issues which add up to contributing to people's quality of life.
