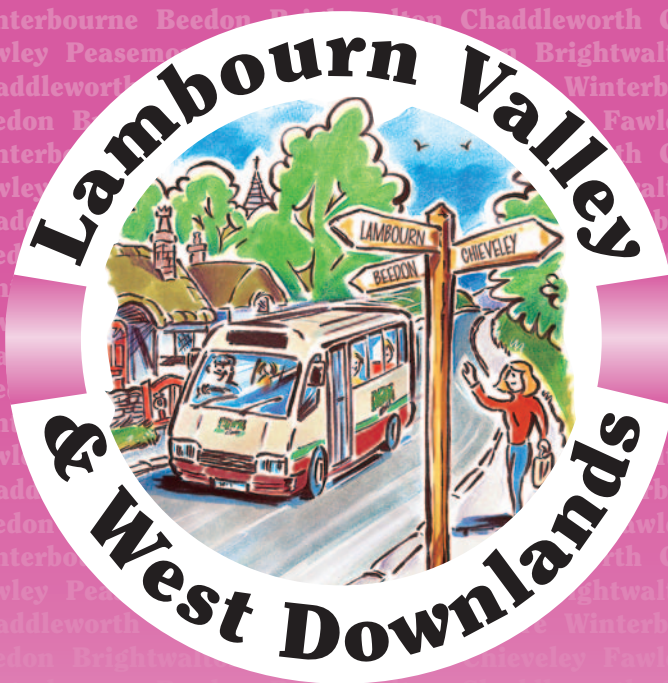

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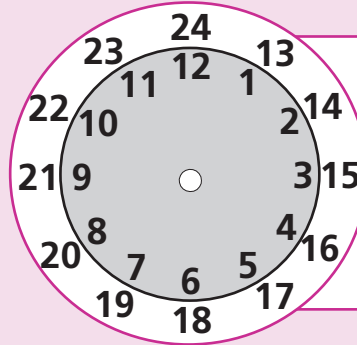
Welcome to the Lambourn Valley & West Downlands Public Transport Guide

Summary of Main Changes

Service 85 and 86: These services operated by Royal Mail Post Bus have been withdrawn.

Service 107: The timetable is revised. It now serves villages that were covered by the Royal Mail Post Bus.

How To Find The Right Bus

Use the index of places at the back of this booklet to find out which buses serve the place you would like to go. For example, if you were in East Garston and wanted to go to Wantage you could follow this procedure. Firstly, find East Garston in the index and see which buses are listed here (the 4, 82 and 90). Then check which of these also serve Wantage (the 82). You know that the 82 serves both East Garston and Wantage so you can check this timetable for a suitable bus. If you need further help planning your journey please phone the Traveline public Transport enquiry service on **0870 608 2 608**.

Who is responsible for your bus service?

Local bus services fall into two categories: firstly, those which are provided as a commercial business venture by the operator; secondly, those which are subsidised under a contract with either West Berkshire Council or one of the neighbouring authorities. Some services include journeys of both types.



Services 4, 6, 90, 95 and 107 are financially supported by West Berkshire Council. Service 4 is funded by West Berkshire Council through the Rural Bus Subsidy Grant. Services 90 and 95 are funded with a Rural Bus Challenge grant.

The Bus Appeals Body

If you have a complaint about the operation of your local bus service you should bring it to the attention of the Bus Company. If the service is subsidised you should also inform the respective Council.

The Bus Appeals Body is a national independent body that acts as an arbiter in unresolved disputes between passengers and operators. You may wish to contact the Bus Appeals Body if you feel the Bus Company has not responded satisfactorily to your complaint.

Timetable changes

Bus companies may change their commercial services as and how they see fit with only eight weeks notice, or even less in some cases. This Transport guide is up to date at the time of going to print, but changes - some minor, some major - may occur after the publication date. If in doubt please check with the operator using the addresses and phone numbers shown in this book, or contact

Why Use a Bus?

For many journeys nothing could be simpler. With convenient bus stopping places in your area, you will not have far to walk to your nearest boarding point.

The wide network of services available is designed to cater not only for journeys to work or school, but also for shopping and leisure trips.

Each bus carries between 8 - 72 customers and represents a much more efficient use of both road space and fossil fuels. Evening services will allow you to enjoy a night on the town without worrying about drinking and driving. A range of fare deals are available making travel exceptionally good value.

Travelling by Bus

The following information should help make your journey easier and more enjoyable. The information given relates specifically to Newbury Buses and some operators may operate differently.

Catching a Bus

Some bus stops are clearly marked. Others are identified on the timetables (but remember that some buses go to different destinations from the same stop, please check the number on the front of the bus to ensure it is the correct one for you). Simply signal to the driver that you wish him to stop. The doors open automatically once the bus is stationary. Let other customers get off first. Once aboard state your destination and, wherever possible, have the correct money as this minimises any delay. Your ticket or TravelCard should be retained throughout your journey as proof of payment.

Hail and Ride

In many rural areas, buses operate on a hail and ride system. The buses will stop when they are hailed providing it is safe for them to do so.

No Smoking

In the interests of customer comfort and safety there is a total smoking ban on all Newbury Buses' vehicles.

Accessibility

Some low floor buses operate within West Berkshire. These provide for easier access especially for the elderly, parents with buggies, and those in wheelchairs. The bus used on services 90, 95 and 107 are wheelchair accessible.

Pets

Small pets may be carried, but a charge of 50p will be made for dogs other than guide dogs and hearing for the deaf dogs which travel free. For your own comfort and theirs, we recommend that you travel off-peak whenever possible.

Luggage

Almost all our buses have storage space for luggage and larger items of shopping. These are clearly marked.

Concessionary Travel

Day Return Tickets (Newbury Buses)

Available for adults (and children except before 9.00am on Schooldays) for journeys wholly or partially outside the Newbury/Thatcham zonal area where the adult single fare exceeds £1.00.

Children can buy a £1.50 Newbury/Thatcham zonal area ticket before 9.00am which allows unlimited travel for one day within the zonal area.

Valid for unlimited travel on all local services operated by Reading Buses and Newbury Buses. Available from Newbury Bus Station Travel Office.

Busabout

The Busabout ticket allows unlimited travel for one day on Newbury Buses and is also valid on the services of other operators including Reading Buses (and Hampshire Bus journeys on service 32/32A).

The low cost way of getting about for the day, it is available in three versions:-

Child £3.50

Family £10.00*

*Family = 2 Adults and 2 Children or 1 Adult and 3 Children

Children under five years of age, accompanied by an adult and not occupying a seat, are carried free of charge. Children of five years of age or more travel at reduced children's fares until their sixteenth birthday. Please note that children's fares are not available after 10.00pm.

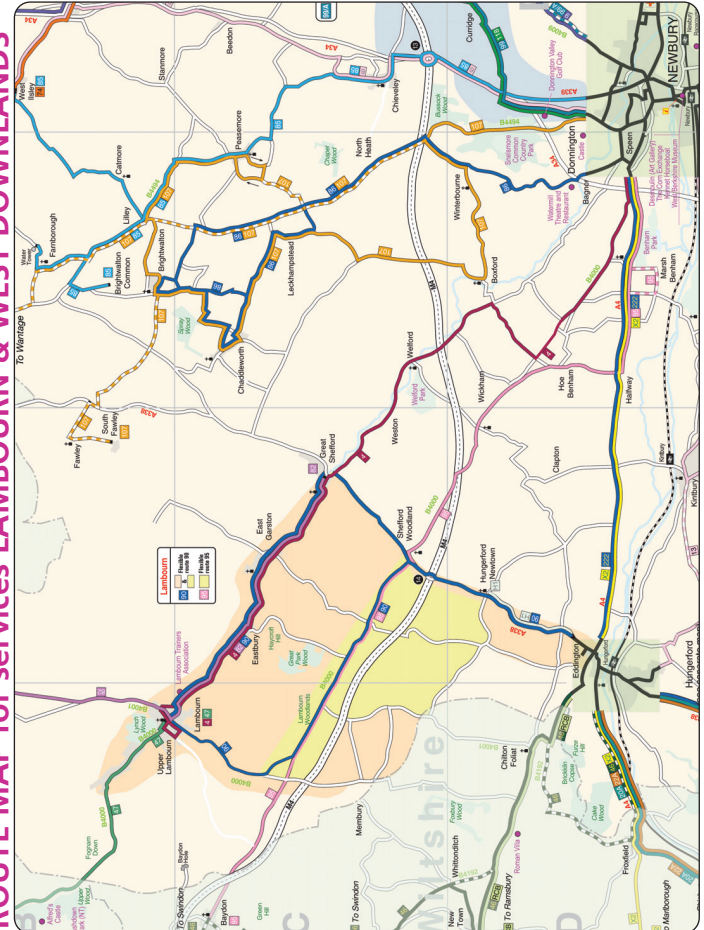





Services 90, 95

Call-A-Bus is operated in partnership between West Berkshire Council and Collins of Newbury, and is funded by the Government Rural Bus Challenge grant. The vehicles are wheelchair accessible.

How Does It Differ From Ordinary Bus Services?

Although the service has a route and timetable like conventional bus services, the service differs in two ways:

- Certain stops are request or set down only
- The service can be booked in advance

Along the fixed route you can catch the bus at bus stops in the usual manner.

Advance Bookings (0118 975 3070)

If you wish the bus to serve a request stop, or an address within any village served by a particular journey, please contact the Call Centre at least 30 minutes before the bus is due. The Call Centre will check if your address is in the request area and tell you when and where the bus can collect you.

If you have bulky luggage, please confirm when booking to make sure it can be accommodated.

The Call Centre is open Monday to Friday between 0800 and 1700, and on Saturdays between 0800 and 1630.

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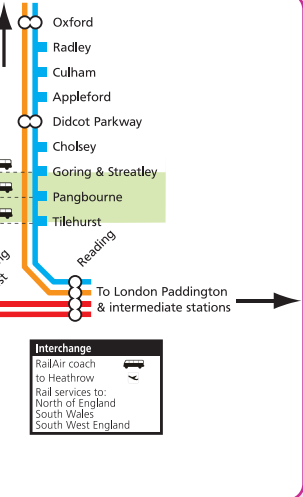
