

If you can't come to us, we'll come to you.

Do you find it difficult to visit your local library, possibly because of age, disability or other special circumstance? Perhaps you are a carer yourself and cannot get to a library?

If so, we may be able to bring the library service to you, in your own home.

What do we offer?

A member of staff will visit you to discuss your requirements, to find out what sort of books you enjoy and whether you prefer hardbacks or paperbacks, large print books or perhaps audiobooks (spoken word items). If you want to use our e-library service, we can help you with that, too.

We will enrol you as an At Home library member but we will keep your library card for you.



A library volunteer will then choose and deliver books to your home at a pre-arranged date and time, usually every three weeks. You can request favourite authors or particular titles and we will be happy to get them for you if we can.

Our library volunteers are friendly and always enjoy a chat. They have all been DBS (Police) checked.
