

ROUTE 1

- 1 Following the map in an anticlockwise direction, begin at Falkland Memorial, Wash Common.
- 2 Follow road around to the R (ignoring straight road)
- 3 Turn L at T-junction.
- 4 Turn R down Spring Lane.
(+/- 150m from the Carpenters Pub) ↓
- 5 At junction, turn R (Sign posted: Echchinswell 3m).
- 6 Where road dips, turn L (Opps Sydmonton Court Estate). Steep downhill over bumpy road surface. [Caution] ⚠ Be aware of dirt and animals on the road.
- 7 Follow the road L at the junction.
- 8 Very steep downhill with blind bends. Sharp R bend (90°) at bottom leading onto a bridge with slightly raised surface. [Caution Possible flooding in Terrenal Rain] ⚠
- 9 Turn L at T-junction. After +100m, turn R.
Steep downhill follows. [Caution] ⚠
- 10 Very steep uphill with sharp bends. [Caution] ⚠
- 11 As you enter Burghclere, turn R at the fork. (Harts Lane)
- 12 Turn R (Sign posted: Highclere Village and Penwood)
- 13 Steep downhill. Turn R just after corner. (Sign posted: Penwood Nursery)
- 14 R turn to join Andover Rd.

ROUTE 2

- 1-3 as Route One.
- 15 Turn R
- 16 Turn L at bottom of long downhill. (Sign posted: kingsclere and Old Burghclere)
- 17 Follow signs to Kingsclere.
- 18 For The Crown Pub, turn R, at Kingsclere T-junction. ↓
At the next T-junction, turn R again. Follow the road into town. Church on R; Crown Pub on L.
- 19 Narrow road!
The Royal Oak Pub on L at T-junction. ↓
Turn R (sign posted: Newbury).
- 20 Turn L down Featherbed Lane. (sign posted: Adbury 1, Newtown 1 1/3)
- 21 Sharp R, follow road (DO NOT take the L lane).
then:
- 8-14 as Route One.
