**The West Berkshire District Council (Speen Lodge Court, Speen)
Public Spaces Protection Order 2020**

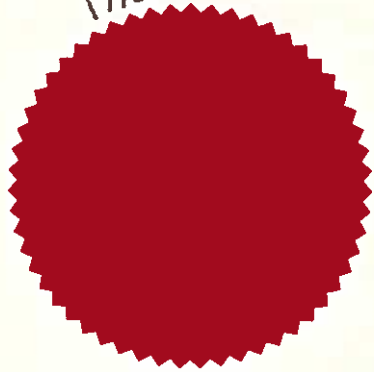
West Berkshire District Council ("the Council") has made the following Public Spaces Protection Order under section 59, 60 and 61 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 ("the Act") and this Order shall come into operation on the 20 day of October 2020. The Council having been satisfied on reasonable grounds that activities carried out in the public space within the Council's area have had a detrimental effect on the quality of life of those in the locality or it is likely that activities will be carried on in a public place within that area and the effect or likely effect of these activities is likely to be of a persistent or continuing nature, or is likely to be such as to make the activities unreasonable and the effect justifies the restriction imposed. The activities include crime including damage to property and anti-social behaviour in Speen Lodge Court.

1. This Order relates to the footway between Speen Lodge and A4 Bath Road, Speen as shown edged in red on the map attached ("the Restricted Area") being land in the area of the Council which is land to which the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 applies and will be protected by the making of this Order.
2. The Order may be cited as The West Berkshire District Council (Speen Lodge Court, Speen) Public Spaces Protection Order 2020 and shall come into force on the 20th October 2020 for a duration of 3 years.
3. The effect of this Order is that no person shall use the Restricted Area at any time unless included within a category of person below.
4. The prohibition in paragraph 3 of this Order shall not apply to any police, ambulance or fire service personnel acting in pursuance of statutory powers or duties or any statutory undertakers, gas, electricity, water or communications provider or the Highway Authority requiring access to their apparatus situated in the Highway.
5. The prohibition in paragraph 3 shall not apply to any person who has applied to the Council's Building Communities Together Team and has been assessed as being a person who is eligible to use the Restricted Area and received a key for this purpose.
6. A Gate has been installed and is circled in green on the map attached.
7. The maintenance of the Gate will be the responsibility of Transport and Countryside who can be contacted at West Berkshire District Council, Council Offices, Market Street, Newbury, Berkshire, RG14 5LD on telephone number 01635 519627.
8. The alternative route for pedestrians is via the A4 Bath Road, the Old Bath Road, Speen Lane and is shown edged in blue on the map attached.
9. A person who fails to comply with the prohibition in paragraph 3 of this Order, under section 67 of the Act is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale or fixed penalty notice of a maximum £100.
10. If any interested person desires to question the validity of this order on the grounds that the Council had no power to make it or that any requirement of the act has not been complied with in relation to this order, he or she may apply to the High Court within six weeks from the date on which this order is made.
