



The West Berkshire District Council (Thatcham Town Centre)
Public Spaces Protection Order 2022

West Berkshire District Council ("the Council") has made the following Public Spaces Protection Order under section 59 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 ("the Act") and this Order shall come into operation on the 11th day of November 2022. The Council having been satisfied on reasonable grounds that activities carried out in the public space within the Council's area have had a detrimental effect on the quality of life of those in the locality or it is likely that activities will be carried on in a public space within that area and the effect or likely effect of these activities is, or is likely to be, of a persistent or continuing nature, such as to make the activities unreasonable and justify the restrictions imposed. The activities include persons behaving in a manner that has caused or is likely to cause, nuisance, harassment, alarm or distress.

1. This Order relates to Thatcham Town Centre as shown edged in red on the map attached ("the Restricted Area") being land in the area of the Council which is land to which the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 applies and will be protected by the making of this Order.
2. The Order may be cited as the West Berkshire District Council (Thatcham Town Centre) Public Spaces Protection Order 2022 and shall come into force on the 11th November 2022 and last for a period of 3 years.
3. The effect of this Order is that any person behaving in a manner that has caused, or is likely to cause, nuisance, harassment, alarm or distress must leave the Restricted Area when requested to do so by an authorised officer for a specified time, and not return to that area for a period not exceeding 24 hours.
4. An authorised officer, as referred to in paragraph 3 of this Order, includes a constable, namely a police officer and a police community support officer or a person who has been authorised for this purpose by the Council.
5. Any person who fails to comply with the requirement in paragraph 3 of this Order, under section 67 of the Act is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale or a Fixed Penalty Notice up to a maximum of £100.
6. If any interested person desires to question the validity of this Order on the grounds that the Council has no power to make it or that any requirement of this Act has not been complied with in relation to this Order, he or she may apply to the High Court within six weeks from the date on which the Order is made.

**Public Spaces Protection Order (PSPO) for Thatcham Town Centre
Restricted Area**



Thatcham PSPO 'Restricted Area' borders and includes the Memorial Field down to the A4 Bath Road to the High Street, down Green Lane to the junction with Lower Way/Church Gate, Station Road to Niddegen Close along public footpath (public right of way THAT/20A/1) to Station Road to the junction with The Moors, up to Chapel Street becoming Bath Road, bordering Gilbert Court to Brownsfield Road.

Including: Memorial Field, Thatcham Health Centre, Thatcham library, Clock Tower, Memorial Hall, War Memorial, Crown Mead, St Marys Church, High Street, The Broadway and the Kingsland Centre.

Roads/Streets within the area: A4 Bath Road, Green Lane, Lower Way/ Church Gate, Niddegen Close, along public footpath (public right of way THAT/20A/1), High Street, The Broadway, Station Road, The Moors, Chapel Street/Bath Road, Tudor Court, Brownsfield Road, Cedar Grove, Meadow Close and Church Lane.
