





Christmas Tree Recycling

If you are a subscriber to the garden waste collection service you can get your real Christmas tree collected. Please put it out with your garden waste bin for collection between 9 Jan until 3 Feb 2023. Trees over 4ft must be cut in half. If you do not subscribe to the garden waste collection service then Christmas trees can be taken to one of our household waste recycling centres.
