As promised, please find our latest response to the above planning application. I consider that it isn't a recommendation as of yet, although after all the work that we, the local highway authority have done, there is a potential way forward towards a recommendation.

I held a meeting internally with highways and parking colleagues yesterday morning. There is some division of opinion, but I consider that the attached response carefully encapsulates where the local highway authority currently is on this proposal with regards to the issue of on-site car parking provision. I consider that the potential way forward has an element of reluctance about it, and much now depends on how the applicants and the agents react and respond to the items being put forward, particularly towards the end of the attached.
