Comments

I have multiple concerns with the submission of the Hungerford Neighbourhood Plan, I am concerned around the impartiality of those that have compiled the report and the decisions that it implies have been made or consulted on – when in fact it has ignored any local concerns.

Housing is a big issue - there are errors in their analysis, local feedback around traffic issues and other comments have been totally ignored. The sites chosen as totally impractical. The council should study the materials and look at the errors in how these have been selected. The site of smitham bridge road is totally inaccessible. The site is liable to flooding and the environmental ecology will be severely damaged. It will put at risk one of the key industrial estates.

I agree we need more housing, but the siting of it must be reviewed and planned out properly – Salisbury Road already has the facilities and best suited for ease of building.

The rest of the plan is light on other details and therefore cannot be really adopted as a plan as there is nothing to adopt – except problem statements and not resolutions.
