My name is Rosalind Heyland and I am a resident of Cottrell Close in Hungerford.

I am writing because I have just heard about the proposal to build 12 new houses at the back of Cottrell Close.

And I am not happy about the plan.

The entrance off the A4 can be difficult to exit with the constant speed and stream of vehicles using the road. It may be a 30 miles an hour zone but a huge number of vehicles don't seem to recognise this.

If you want to try and walk into Hungerford, which I frequently do, you are assaulted by the fumes and close proximity of some very big lorries with some parts of the pavement being extremely narrow. Not a pleasant experience.

The number of extra vehicles coming up the close also concerns me. We already have lots of delivery vans during the course of the day so there would be a lot of extra traffic from both the new residents and the services that they would use.

A number of young children play in the street and this would be an extra hazard for them as there is no childrens play area.
