

**WEST BERKSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL
(B4009 LONG LANE/SHAW HILL, SHAW-CUM-DONNINGTON,
COLD ASH, CHIEVELEY & NEWBURY)
(30 M.P.H & 50 M.P.H SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2026**

WEST BERKSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL has **MADE** an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to extend the existing 30mph speed limit on the B4009 Long Lane (north of Highwood Close) northwards by a further 37m (approx.) and reduce the adjoining 50mph speed limit by the same distance.

The Order was made on Tuesday 17th February 2026 and will come into effect on Friday 27th February 2026.

Copies of the Order, part revoked Order, explanatory statement and plan can be inspected during the hours of 9.00 a.m. to 4.30 p.m. Monday to Friday at the offices of West Berkshire District Council (at main reception on the Ground Floor) Council Offices Market Street Newbury RG14 5LD and on the Council's Website www.westberks.gov.uk/b4009-long-lane-30 or by scanning the QR code opposite.



If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you, may within six weeks from the 17th February 2026 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
