

**WEST BERKSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL
(OXFORD ROAD, DONNINGTON)
(30 M.P.H SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2026**

WEST BERKSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL has **MADE** an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to extend the 30mph speed limit on Oxford Road in Donnington northwards from its junction with The Chase to its junction with Shawdene. The Order also revokes the **ROYAL COUNTY OF BERKSHIRE (OXFORD ROAD, DONNINGTON) (SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 1995** in its entirety.

The Order was made on Tuesday 3rd March 2026 and will come into force on Friday 13th March 2026.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from the 3rd March 2026, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
