

**WEST BERKSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL  
(SULHAMSTEAD HILL, SULHAMSTEAD)  
(30 M.P.H SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2026**

**WEST BERKSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL** has **MADE** an Order under Sections 82, 83 and 84(1) and (2) and of Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to extend the 30mph speed limit from Sulhamstead village northwards to the A4.

The Order also revokes the **ROYAL COUNTY OF BERKSHIRE (RESTRICTED ROADS) (SULHAMSTEAD ROAD/SULHAMSTEAD HILL, SULHAMSTEAD) (NO:4) ORDER 1986** in its entirety.

The Order was made on Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> March 2026 and will come into force on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> March 2026.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from the 17<sup>th</sup> March 2026, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
